The successful candidate will be an internationally acknowledged social scientist with particular interests in international and transnational relations research. She/he is expected to research at the Institute of Political Science, particularly at the Institute for Development and Peace (INEF). She/he will notably focus on the research field of "responsibility and cooperation in a conflictive global society", to which INEF contributes, among other places, at the Centre for Global Cooperation Research's (Käte Hamburger Kolleg) "Political Cultures of Global Society". Furthermore, he/she will teach in relevant study programs of the Faculty of Social Sciences, where questions of global and transnational cooperation are of particular importance. He/she will especially contribute to the MA in International Relations and Development Policy, the MA in Development and Governance, as well as the BA in Political Science.

A requirement is a theoretical orientation around concepts of global governance and global society, in which questions addressing local and cultural diversity should be included. Relevant publications, familiarity with international discourse (for example at relevant conferences), and teaching experience are expected.

Very good oral and written knowledge of the English language is indispensable. Candidates will also be required to have some knowledge of German at the time of application. A period of three years will be allowed within which the post-holder must achieve a level of German sufficient to enable them to teach in German and fully participate in the management of the institutes. The university will provide support for language learning.

Applicants are expected to show a willingness to engage in interdisciplinary cooperation and collaboration in major future research projects as well as publications in peer-reviewed journals and experience in the execution of projects financed by third-party funds, particularly projects funded by the DFG (German Research Foundation).

Teaching commitments amount to four semester hours per week during the first phase and five hours per week in the second phase of employment.
