What is the Master in Sustainable Development and Global Governance (MASUS) all about?

MASUS is a Master Program in Sustainable Development and Global Governance @ Carlos III University of Madrid (UC3M). Based on an understanding that environmental and socio-economic sustainability are closely linked and that global governance has an imminent role in both, MASUS provides comprehensive training to tackle multifaceted challenges of sustainability.

What does MASUS offer?

MASUS is a one year-and-a half-long master program that

- focuses on some of the most pressing issues of sustainability such as climate change and energy, biodiversity, poverty and inequality.
- equips students with state-of-the-art tools to design and implement integrative solutions to sustainability.
- provides a vanguard multidisciplinary training by bringing together experts from a wide range of disciplines in natural and social sciences.
- taught entirely in English by a diverse faculty from 8 distinct departments at 7 universities and research centers.
- combines theory and practice enabling hands-on analysis of real-world cases.
- offered by UC3M, among the best universities in the world regarding employability, and situated in Puerta de Toledo Campus in the heart of Madrid, a city that offers a great student life besides diverse attractions.

Is MASUS specialized in a specific dimension of sustainability?

Encouraging applications from all academic and professional backgrounds, MASUS offers conceptual and methodological training in different areas of sustainable development based on four modules:

- Introduction to sustainability entailing foundations of complex systems for sustainability and governance, methods and integrative workshops;
- Socioeconomic sustainability focusing on issues like poverty, inequality, gender, and sustainable work;
- Environmental sustainability addressing issues like climate change, energy and global governance, ecosystems and planetary health;
- Global governance dealing with geopolitics of natural resources, conflict and development, internatonal law and green politics, among others.

What kind of career opportunities does MASUS prepare its students for?

Our graduates are likely candidates for a broad range of future careers including:

- Public offices specialized in climate change, environmental governance, alleviation of social risk, poverty and inequality,
- International, regional and supranational organizations dealing with sustainability issues (such as the UN and EU agencies),
- Private sector entities committed to developing sustainable solutions,
- Research institutes and think tanks.
