By designating the congress theme as “World capitalism, governance and community: Toward a Corporate Millennium?”, the President and Programme Committee have boldly focused issues of acute importance for the current world situation. This feature, along with the greatly expanded number of special sessions, have been made possible by combining the potential of the Internet with the co-operative talents of the IPSA membership.

What you hold in your hands, therefore, is the most extensive congress programme in the history of IPSA. The Programme Committee has taken a particular responsibility for convening main-theme panels, and the Research Committees have responded positively across the board to a special initiative by the Local Organizing Committee to chart the “development of the discipline”.

It is an exceptional pleasure for IPSA to return to Canada and to Quebec on the occasion of its eighteenth world congress. Our world congress has been held in North America on only two earlier occasions. Many of those attending our current congress will recall that in 1973 a very successful IPSA world congress took place in Montreal.

It is also of some significance that this is the fiftieth anniversary of the very first IPSA world congress, which took place in Zurich in September 1950. The small scale of the Zurich event – it was attended by only 81 participants – illustrates the modest beginnings of IPSA, and the sheer scale of the present congress is a reminder of how far we have progressed in the meantime.

This event is an impressive testimony to the endeavours and to the skill of the local organisers, who first began work on this project five years ago. One of the central functions of the local organisers has been the provision of a framework for the implementation of an academic programme whose theoretical and academic basis has been laid by the programme committee, and especially by the programme chair, over the past three years. The challenge of selecting main theme sessions related to the theme of “world capitalism, governance and community” has required a formidable intellectual and organisational commitment on the part of the programme chair, to whose achievement the present document is a tribute.

As IPSA secretary general, I am delighted to have an opportunity of congratulating the programme chair, the programme committee and the local organisers on the fruit of their labours, now condensed into this volume. The scope of the programme illustrates aptly the rich intellectual heritage that lies behind the world congress. But it is impossible not to be struck also by the sheer diversity of the academic agenda of our discipline, as illustrated by the methodological and substantive diversity of panels and papers alike.

It is to be hoped, then, that IPSA’s millennial congress will illustrate the remarkable advances within the discipline in the last half century. It is entirely appropriate to conclude by thanking the great body of colleagues whose commitment has played so vital a role in developing this programme: the convenors, chairs, paper givers and discussants whose contributions will give life to this entire undertaking.

## MOT DE BIENVENUE AUX CONGRESSISTES

Un quart de siècle s'est écoulé depuis la tenue, à Montréal, en 1973, du IX<sup>e</sup> Congrès de l'Association internationale de science politique.

Société turbulente à la fin des années 70, le Québec s'est assagi, tout en enregistrant les leçons d'une remise en question rapide et radicale de ses schèmes de pensée et de vie traditionnels. À la faveur de la Révolution tranquille, l'appareil étatique s'est développé et modernisé tout à la fois.

La société québécoise, naguère marquée par une fécondité exceptionnelle, glisse vers un vieillissement rapide et prononcé. Profondément secouée dans ses fondements, cette société s'est sécularisée à une vitesse exceptionnelle. Les piliers institutionnels d'hier, à commencer par l'Église catholique, se sont lézardés, pour ne pas dire plus.

Durement secoué par les récessions du début des années 80 et 90, le Québec n'a pas moins vu apparaître une génération d'entrepreneurs qui se sont taillés une belle place au soleil. Ces entrepreneurs jouent le jeu du marché international, tel Bombardier pour ne citer que la plus prestigieuse des multinationales née et toujours basée au Québec. Quant à la population, elle s'est résolument prononcée, fin des années 80, en faveur de l'accord de libre échange avec les USA, au grand désarroi d'une partie du Canada anglais.

L'évolution constitutionnelle du Québec n'est plus un mystère pour la plupart des politologues du monde entier. Deux référendums plus tard, la question du statut du Québec demeure, irrésolue, lancinante. À Québec comme à Ottawa, deux partis politiques défendent la thèse d'une indépendance inscrite à l'enseigne d'un souverainisme qui s'inspire à l'occasion du cheminement de l'Union européenne.

Bienvenue à Québec, berceau de la civilisation française en Amérique du Nord comme en témoignent ces quartiers hérités du régime français. Bienvenue à Québec où s'est implanté, voilà près de 50 ans, le premier département de science politique de langue française au Québec et au Canada. Au nom des politologues, chercheurs et étudiants répartis dans les universités francophones et anglophones du Québec, je tiens à vous souhaiter un séjour agréable, un congrès tonifiant et des découvertes mémorables.

## Structure de l'AISP

---

L'AISP est une association à but non-lucratif qui fut fondée en 1949 par des associations nationales de science politique, sous l'égide de l'UNESCO. Parmi ses activités principales, il y a l'organisation d'un congrès mondial triennal sur les questions de science politique, auquel participent surtout des universitaires de la discipline. De surcroît, l'AISP commandite divers comités de recherche et des réunions de spécialistes telles que des tables rondes et des ateliers de réflexion. L'AISP contribue également grandement à la presse spécialisée. Finalement, l'AISP est consciente de l'importance du travail interdisciplinaire et travaille à ce titre de concert avec d'autres associations internationales.

L'AISP possède un statut consultatif auprès du Conseil Économique et Social des Nations Unies ainsi que de l'UNESCO. Son siège légal se trouve à Paris (France), à la «Fondation Nationale des Sciences Politiques». Actuellement son secrétariat est situé au département de politique de l'«University College Dublin» à Dublin (Irlande).

## Structure of IPSA

---

The International Political Science Association (IPSA), founded under the auspices of UNESCO in 1949, is an international scholarly association. Its legal seat is in Paris, at the Fondation Nationale des Sciences Politiques. Its objectives are to promote the advancement of political science through the collaboration of scholars in different parts of the world; to organise world congresses and other academic activities; to provide documentary and reference services; to facilitate the spread of political science information; and to promote internationally planned research.

IPSA has more than 40 collective members (national and regional political science associations), more than 100 associate members (political science departments and other institutions concerned with political science) and more than 1,000 individual members. It has consultative status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations and with UNESCO, and is a member of the International Social Science Council and of the International Committee for Social Science Information and Documentation.

IPSA's affairs are managed by a Council, on which all collective members are represented, which meets once every three years; and, between meetings of the Council, by an Executive Committee elected for a three year term. The day-to-day affairs of the Association are administered by its Secretary General and by a permanent secretariat. This is currently located at University College Dublin, Ireland.

# WORLD CAPITALISM, GOVERNANCE AND COMMUNITY

## *Toward a Corporate Millennium?*

As fate would have it, the turning of the millennium has double significance for the International Political Science Association. In 1999 the organization registers its fiftieth year of service to the discipline, and in the year 2000 itself the triennial World Congress will be jointly hosted by the Canadian and Quebec associations in Quebec City. While calendars are at best necessary conventions — and, at worst, extraneous culture-bound constraints — they are nonetheless necessary for celebrations. Fifty years is a respectable age for a modern organization, and 2000 years (by any calendar) is surely a worthy juncture for taking the measure of an even more ancient field of thought and action.

In choosing the theme “*World capitalism, governance and community: Toward a corporate millennium?*”, President Ted Lowi and the Executive Committee of IPSA have decided to focus on a complex of interrelated issues which are currently having an enormous impact on the boundaries and institutions of global, regional, national and local politics. Though the post-Cold War period is but a decade old, it has been a decade of exceptional change and impact for this century. The decline of aggressive missionary communism throughout the world has left a power vacuum which the new economic constellations of North America, Europe and the Far East are competing to fill; and the ideology of free-market economics has gained world-wide recognition.

The changes in question have increasingly been treated under the rubric of “globalization”; a catch-all phrase which emphasizes the emergence of a truly global economy along with the spread of Western values and institutions. By shifting the emphasis from “globalization” to “world capitalism”, and by specifically focusing on the *corporate* aspect of change, the main theme of the Quebec Congress highlights the organizational and goal-oriented dimension of the process. “Corporate” refers, in this sense, not only to the institutional driving force of an increasingly globalized capitalism (multi- and cross-national corporations), but also to what appears to be a more general tendency toward supranational economic and political organization at the expense of state power and identity. The European Union, NAFTA and the World Trade Organization, while all ostensibly free-trade organizations, also contain a vital aspect of corporate thinking: the merging of disparate collective actors and interests into a new hierarchically structured and legally regulated body.

By posing the rhetorical question as to whether we are moving toward a new era of both vastly more powerful and essentially different corporate forms and processes, the main theme lays down a challenge for political scientists of all sub-disciplines to bring their findings, perspectives and opinions to the debate in Quebec. What are the effects of “the corporate turn” on existing forms of gover-

nance and community? How will the transition from a primarily nation-based system of economic production and competition to an increasingly integrated system of world capitalism and regional corporate-political coordination of trade and markets, affect traditional models of democratic governance and citizen identity? What new power constellations and alliances are emerging, and how can we assess the balance between positive and negative effects?

Panels and special sessions related to the main theme will be grouped under five major sub-themes:

**Globalization, sovereignty and legitimacy**

**Citizenship, values and identity**

**Institutions, interests and policies**

**World politics, environment and development**

**Theory, knowledge and technology**

The members of the Program Committee will serve as session convenors for the main theme, actively seeking a limited number of panel chairs to highlight the theme across a broad spectrum of regions and sub-disciplines. The sub-themes can also serve as rough guidelines for those wishing to propose individual papers, panels, special sessions, round-table discussions, or sessions of other types, and IPSA’s Research Committees and Study Groups will be encouraged to consider the sub-themes when they propose their own sessions of panels. The Program Chair will make every effort to coordinate sessions so that it will be possible for those with sub-disciplinary interests to attend as many sessions within a given area as possible.

In conclusion, I would like to stress that a main theme is just that — a *main* theme. When successful, it serves to focus an important issue, inspire debate, and — hopefully — attract participants who might otherwise not attend the Congress. The main theme can be viewed in this respect as a large tone-setting symposium within the Congress itself. As everyone who has ever attended an IPSA World Congress knows, however, the scope and heterogeneity of sessions and activities is enormous; and we hardly expect the millennium Congress to be any different in this respect. On the contrary, we believe that the program for the Quebec 2000 Congress will be the largest and most exciting in the organization’s 50-year history. The debate in Canada itself on issues of federalism, sovereignty and identity; the crucial issues relating to the further consolidation of the European Union; the growing importance of global issues of environment and development; issues of democratization, human rights, and the clash of civilizations — all these and much, much more will complement, supplement and enliven the program in Quebec.

# CAPITALISME MONDIAL, GOUVERNANCE ET COMMUNAUTÉ

## *Vers un millénaire de corporations?*

Comme par hasard, la fin du millénaire prend une double signification pour l'Association internationale de science politique. En 1999, l'organisation en sera à sa cinquantième année au service de cette discipline, et en l'an 2000, les associations du Québec et du Canada accueilleront conjointement le Congrès mondial triennal dans la ville de Québec. Cinquante ans est un âge respectable pour toute organisation moderne, et 2000 ans (tous calendriers confondus) représentent certainement une bonne occasion pour prendre la mesure d'un champ de pensée et d'action encore plus ancien.

En choisissant le thème «**Capitalisme mondial, gouvernance et communauté: vers un millénaire des corporations**», le président Theodore Lowi et le Comité exécutif ont décidé de concentrer l'attention sur un réseau complexe de problèmes qui ont en ce moment une influence considérable sur les frontières et les institutions de la politique globale, régionale, nationale et locale. Bien que la guerre froide ne remonte qu'à dix ans, cette décennie fut une période de changements exceptionnels se répercutant sur tout le siècle. Le déclin du communisme missionnaire a laissé un vide au niveau du pouvoir mondial, vide que les nouvelles constellations économiques de l'Amérique du Nord, d'Europe et d'Extrême-Orient s'efforcent de remplir. L'idéologie de l'économie de marché est maintenant reconnue mondialement.

Ces changements ont de plus en plus été traités sous la rubrique «globalisation», expression générale qui souligne l'émergence d'une économie véritablement globale ainsi que la généralisation des valeurs et des institutions occidentales. En déplaçant l'accent de la «globalisation» vers un «capitalisme mondial», et en soulignant de façon spécifique l'aspect corporatif de ces changements, le thème principal du Congrès de Québec met en évidence la dimension organisationnelle qui alimente ce processus. «Millénaire des corporations», en ce sens, réfère au moteur institutionnel d'un capitalisme de plus en plus globalisé (entreprises multi et transnationales). Mais aussi à ce qui semble être une tendance plus générale vers une organisation politique et économique supranationale qui rivalise l'identité nationale et le pouvoir de l'État. L'Union Européenne, l'ALÉNA et l'Organisation Mondiale du Commerce, tout en étant des organisations de libre échange contiennent également un aspect vital de réflexion collective: la fusion d'acteurs et d'intérêts collectifs disparates en une institution nouvelle structurée selon une hiérarchie et réglée légalement.

En posant la question rhétorique de savoir si nous allons vers une ère internationale de formes corporatives à la fois beaucoup plus puissantes et essentiellement différentes, le thème principal lance un défi aux politologues de tous les champs disciplinaires afin qu'ils contribuent au débat de Québec à travers leurs perspectives différentes. Quels sont les effets du «tournant corporatif» sur les formes existantes de gouvernement et de communauté? Comment la transition d'un système de concurrence économique essentiellement étatique vers un système de plus en plus intégré de capitalisme mondial affectera-t-elle les modèles traditionnels d'identité

et de gouvernement démocratique. Quelles sont les constellations et les alliances de pouvoir qui émergeront? Comment pourrions-nous maintenir l'équilibre entre les effets positifs et négatifs?

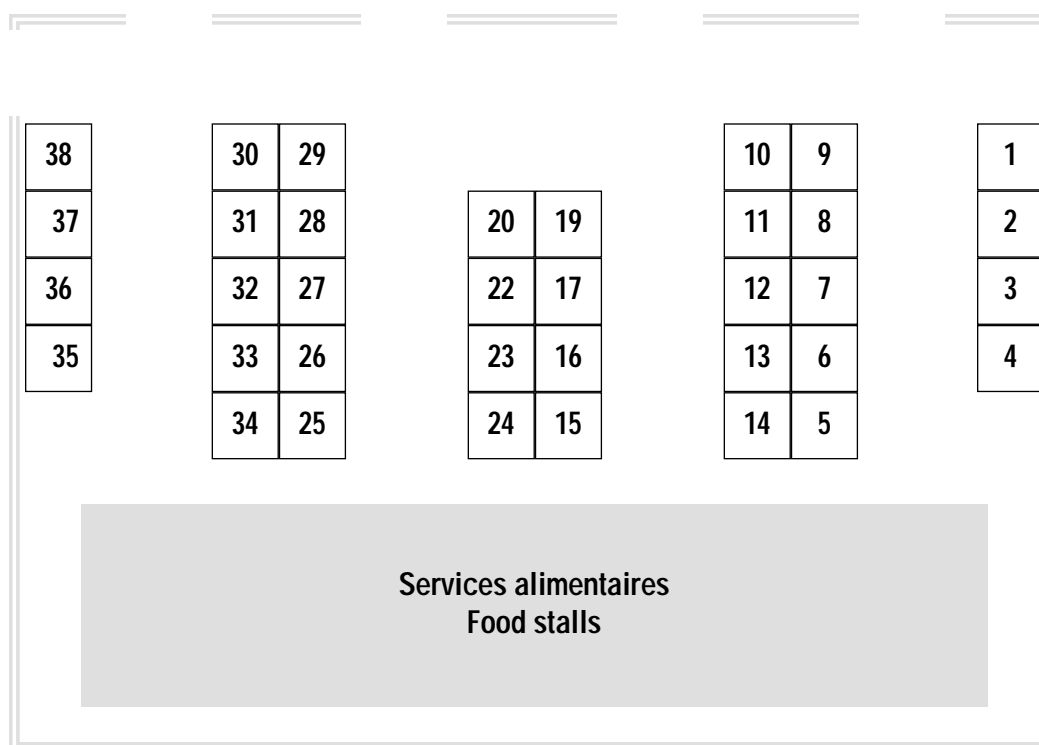
Un effort sera fait de regrouper les séances du thème principal ainsi que des Comités de recherches et des sessions spéciales selon cinq sous-thèmes majeurs:

- I Globalisation, souveraineté et légitimité**
- II Citoyenneté, valeurs et identités**
- III Institutions, intérêts et politiques**
- IV Politique mondiale, environnement et développement**
- V Théorie, connaissances et technologie**

Les membres du Comité du programme agiront en tant que coordonnateurs des sessions regroupées sous ces rubriques, et s'efforceront de trouver un nombre limité d'organiseurs de sessions selon une gamme variée de régions et de champs sous-disciplinaires. Les sous-thèmes peuvent également servir de guides pour ceux qui souhaitent proposer des communications, des sessions spéciales, des tables rondes, ou des sessions d'autres genres. Les Comités de recherche et les Groupes d'études de l'AISP sont encouragés à considérer ces sous-thèmes quand ils proposeront leurs propres sessions. Le directeur du programme s'efforcera de coordonner les sessions de telle sorte qu'il soit possible pour ceux qui s'intéressent particulièrement à un domaine sous-disciplinaire de participer au maximum de sessions dans ce domaine.

En guise de conclusion, j'aimerais insister sur le fait qu'un thème principal n'est que ça — un thème principal. Toujours est-il, que le thème principal ne représente qu'un tiers du Programme complet du Congrès. Il y a aussi les sessions spéciales que tout membre de l'AISP peut proposer et les sessions organisées par les Comités de recherche et les Groupes d'étude qui viennent compléter le Programme dans sa totalité. Néanmoins, utilisé à bon escient, le thème principal sert à concentrer l'attention sur un problème important, à inspirer des débats, et — espérons-le — à attirer des participants qui n'auraient peut-être pas pris part au Congrès autrement. Le thème principal peut être envisagé comme un grand symposium donnant le ton au Congrès. Comme les adeptes des congrès mondiaux le savent bien, la gamme et l'hétérogénéité des sessions sont toujours considérables. Nous ne nous attendons pas à ce que le Congrès du second millénaire diffère dans ce domaine. Au contraire, nous espérons que le programme pour le Congrès de l'an 2000 à Québec sera le plus important et le plus stimulant des cinquante ans d'histoire de l'organisation. Le débat au Canada sur les problèmes de fédéralisme, de souveraineté et d'identité face à la globalisation; les problèmes cruciaux tenant à la consolidation de l'Union Européenne; l'importance grandissante des problèmes d'environnement et de développement; les problèmes de démocratisation, de droits de l'homme et de choc des civilisations — tout ceci et bien plus encore viendra enrichir le programme au Québec.

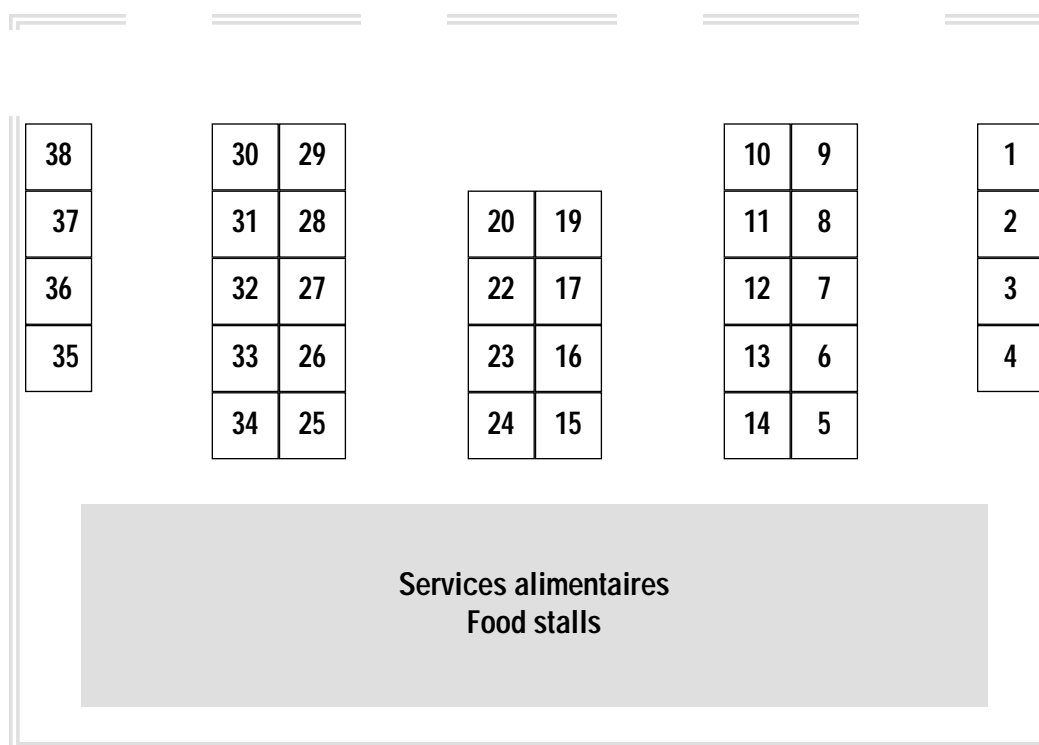
